

DID YOU KNOW THAT THERE'S A CRISIS OF UNDERFUNDING AND UNDERSTAFFING IN PUBLIC EDUCATION IN ONTARIO?



The Ford government has cut \$6.3 billion (cumulative) in per-student funding since 2018 from a system that is already drastically underfunded. Funding cuts are having a serious impact on students, classrooms, and the frontline education workers who support them every day.

Education workers are under extreme pressure:

- Three quarters of CUPE education workers in Ontario report that there are not enough staff at the school board or in their school.
- 73% of EAs and CYWs support five or more students in a normal week. Only 3% of EAs/CYW said they provide one-on-one support to students.

- 75% of all education workers are reporting violent or disruptive incidents are a regular occurrence in schools.

Evacuations are becoming the new norm:

- 74% of EAs/CYW have their work areas (i.e. classrooms) evacuated.
- 1 in 10 say this happens every single day.

What CUPE Education Workers Are Fighting For:

- Increased funding dedicated to hiring education workers to provide supports for your kids
- Minimum staffing thresholds at every school board to protect baseline staffing
- A Designated Early Childhood Educator in every class with a kindergarten student, and smaller kindergarten classes to improve supports to the youngest learners
- Increased hours of work for many classifications to provide more support to students
- Mandatory paid prep time for all workers who require it to do their jobs
- Improvements to wages and benefits to improve the jobs at our schools – in our communities
