THERE'S A CRISIS IN PUBLIC EDUCATION IN ONTARIO.



Since 2018, Ontario's education system has faced a cumulative funding cut of over \$6.4 billion. This has caused a serious staffing crisis in school boards that is affecting students and education workers every single day.



Across the province, there are simply not enough education workers and teachers to provide the support students need to succeed and thrive. Every school board needs more staff – Educational Assistants, Teachers, Custodians, Clerical staff, Early Childhood Educators and smaller class sizes – for students to reach their full potential.



Chronic underfunding continues to shape daily realities in schools, where large class sizes, rising incidents of school violence, insufficient supports for students with special education needs, ongoing challenges in retaining and recruiting teachers and education workers, and aging, deteriorating buildings all converge to create significant strain.
